

NOTICE RE: COVID 19 PREVENTION MEASURES AT RIMROCK 3/20/2020

We would like to share critical information with Rimrock members.

RR is following the lead of local and state governments and the recommendations of local and state health officials and will be immediately closing the entirety of the clubhouse including the kitchen immediately. *The potable water will be left open and available as well as the campground. However, the campground water service is not on at this time. This applies immediately. A determination of the potential long-term closure of the Rimrock facilities is being thoroughly considered at this time.*

The usual opening of the showers on 4/1 will not happen as the Health District has forbidden it. We do not know when we be allowed to open the shower facilities.

Consistent with Rimrock's standing policy at all times, those that wish to use their private property in accordance with state law, and while observing all of Rimrock's governing documents, are free to do so as long as all relevant requirements are observed. Further, The Governor's State of Emergency does not entitle private property owners to stay on their property in substandard / unlawful structures (including but not limited to tents, vehicles, boats, RV's sheds, etc.). All county standards, laws, and regulations must be followed. Please refer to the applicable Washington State Law, Douglas County regulations as well as Douglas / Chelan County Health and Safety regulations and Rimrock Meadows Bylaws and CC&Rs.

To be clear - it is Rimrock's specific intent to discourage all members from attempting to hunker down or self-quarantine at Rimrock.

Employees will generally continue to work and answer telephone calls and e-mails as they have in the past. Although RR is requesting limited contact with staff at this time. Staff may also make themselves available for appointments for special circumstances or emergency situations where an advance appointment is scheduled with them. Contact precautions such as maintaining a prescribed distance between people will be employed.

All of these precautionary measures are being employed solely because of the importance of protecting staff, protecting the members, and protecting the community. These decisions have been made out of an abundance of caution and to curtail all avoidable health consequences.

The only way to limit the spread of the virus is to limit personal interactions and contact with others. These are discretionary decisions being made by the whole of Rimrock's leadership, both staff leadership and board leadership. These decisions have been made after considering relevant factors in an attempt to proactively protect the health of everyone both members and staff.

The board and staff leadership will be meeting within the next 7 days to consider potential ongoing restrictions for the use of all of all of the common facilities at Rimrock.

To recap - Rimrock clubhouse and kitchen are immediately closed for any and all use. There will be no use of the clubhouse or kitchen allowed at this time. The showers will not be opening on 4/1. We do not know when the showers will open.

The potable water station remains available at Horseshoe Park.

The RV campground has all the usual winter restrictions and requirements. The water is not yet turned on in the RV park.

Rimrock staff leadership and the board of directors will be conferring this week to consider ongoing property closure. We will share information once it becomes available.
